## LIVING IN LIGHT OF GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

As we live in light of God's faithfulness we can confess as sinners, endure as sufferers, and walk boldly as saints.

"God sticks to his relationship. He establishes a personal relationship with us and stays with it. The central reality for Christians is the personal, unalterable, persevering commitment God makes to us. Perseverance is not the result of our determination; it is the result of God's faithfulness. We survive in the way of faith not because we have extraordinary stamina but because God is righteous, because God sticks with us. Christian discipleship is a process of paying more and more attention to God's righteousness and less and less attention to our own; finding the meaning of our lives not by probing our moods and motives and morals but by believing in God's will and purpose; making a map of the faithfulness of God, not charting the rise and fall of our enthusiasm. It is out of such a reality that we acquire perseverance."
